MAHARAJA SURAJMAL BRIJ UNIVERSITY has been established by an Act of State of Rajasthan by dividing the area of Rajasthan University in to smaller units to take the higher education to doorstep. The University is in its third year of operation and is having Faculty of Law and three affiliated colleges imparting instruction leading to Bachelors degree in Law.

With appointment of a legal luminary as Vice Chancellor it has been decided to establish an International Institute of Legal Studies to impart instruction for LLM and for Ph.D. in law. The University has established an International Institute of Legal Studies and would work directly under the Vice Chancellor and would substitute its Faculty of Law.

The institute would work on the lines of National Law Schools established in each state under control of High Courts. In state like Maharashtra two National Law Schools have been established. Similarly in Rajasthan it would be the second such institute, the first being at Jodhpur which is also the seat of High Court of Rajasthan. The International Institute of legal Studies shall work in tandem with CLAT and an MOU has already been signed with CLAT 2017 for availing the candidates from CLAT. As the announcement got delayed an entrance test is being organized for half the seats.

It would seek to move along the international pattern of legal education and seek to achieve convergence of laws and train Indian students for working in foreign countries and/or develop work force eligible for advising clients in other countries from Indian soil.

Admission Announcement

The International Centre announces admission to the One Year LL.M. programme and P. G. Diplomas in the listed subjects for the academic session 2017-18 as per the details below. The medium of instruction shall be only English. A candidate who has less than 50% marks cannot be admitted to LLM one year programme

1. Three Streams of LL.M. One year :-

Presently LL.M. is offered in a manner that it caters to three specialized streams :

- i. LLM Intellectual Property Law
- ii. LLM Criminal Law and Cyber Crimes
- iii. LLM Corporate Law

There is placed a cap of 20-25 seats in each stream but University reserves its right to increase or reduce seats.

P. G. Diplomas in Law on self financing mode

The Institute shall offer following P G Diplomas and PG Certificate Course in Law

- 1. Intellectual Property Law**
- 2. Criminal Law**
- 3. Cyber Law**
- 4. Corporate Law**

An optional course or diploma shall not be offered in a LLM stream if the candidates opting for that course are less than 5.

Admission Procedure for LL.M. One Year Programme 2017-18:-

The candidates must have secured minimum percentage of marks in qualifying examination (i.e. LL.B. 3 year/ Five Year Integrated LL.B. (Hons.) or any other equivalent exam) not to be less than 50%. Normal weightage to SC; ST candidate has to be reduced passed by concerned university. The candidates must have passed in the final semester/ final year examination of the qualifying examination on the date of his/her admission.

- a. In case of candidate who has appeared in the qualifying examination, he/she may submit his/her final result of qualifying examination before the stipulated date which is within month of August 2017, otherwise the seat shall be offered to next candidate. Till then such candidates may be given provisional admission. Fee once paid shall not be refundable.
- b. In case of equal marks, the breaking of tie for admission shall be by the procedure as under: (i) Higher age would be given preference; or (ii) Computerized draw of lots.
- c. No student would be eligible to LL.M. One Year Programme unless he/she has passed in the examination conducted by a University leading to the award of LL.B. degree.
- d. There is no upper age limit for LL.M.

***Eligibility Criteria for PG Diploma in Law & PG Certificate Course in Law:** - The candidate (all categories) must have secured minimum percentage of marks in qualifying examination (i.e. LL.B. 3 years/ Five Years Integrated LL.B. Hons. or any other equivalent exam), as per pass marks in the concerned university.

Libraries Liaison and partnerships: University is establishing law library on its campus which is presently located in Government P.G. Law College where the university department is being established.

Books substantial number of including membership of online libraries shall be undertaken in the year 2017. Partnerships shall be forged with established and well-equipped libraries within the State of Rajasthan and other Universities and at ILI, ISIL Delhi and facilitation of students in libraries shall be organised.

Teaching Methods: Teaching methods may include the tutorials, seminars, fieldwork, projects, clinics and other such activities. If the need be, some classes can be organized or compulsory seminars can be prescribed at another convenient station in Rajasthan or Delhi.

The students should be prepared to spend 10 days at their own cost outstation per semester either at Delhi or Jaipur

Duration and Spread of the Programme: The duration of the programme shall be One Year in two semesters with minimum contact hours as per UGC. The work plan includes class room teaching, library work, seminars and research. Teaching Methodology will include Lecture-cum-case discussion, Assignments / Projects, and Presentations.

The Classes are to be held on Friday, Saturday, Sunday or Monday.

Evaluation Scheme would consist of i) Continuous Assessment on the basis of classes/ Project - 30% and ii) End Term Examination 70% in each course.

2. Fee of the LL.M. Course:- Rs 65000/-

The University has decided to run LL.M. Programme within the financial reach of the candidates that is far lesser than other Law Universities of Government and Private sectors running One Year LL.M. Programme all over the country. The fee structure shall be as following: -

**The Semester Fee for the foreign students from Asia would be Rs 50,000/ per semester and other foreign students would be 60,000/- per semester besides all the charges listed above would be payable.

- **The students should be prepared to spend 10 days at their own cost outstation per semester, likely in Delhi or Jaipur.**
- **In First two years of operations it will be in full discretion of University and it may change, alter or substitute any method for instruction and/or examination.**

***Fee Concession :-**

Fee Concession of Rs. 10000 (Per Semester) to deserving candidate on merit cum means basis. merit will be counted in the same proportion 70% - 30% as detailed for admission. There is no fee concession for the candidates applying on CLAT basis.

Suitable scholarships are likely to be announced on finding resources for the scholarship for the session 2017-18 itself.

3. How to Apply:-

Admissions for LLM One Year Programme are on. Candidates may contact and receive Application Forms from the Admission Counter of the MSB University, Bharatpur, Rajasthan - 321001 either by hand with cash payment or by post with Demand Draft drawn in favor of the "Maharaja Surajmal Brij University, Bharatpur" payable at Bharatpur.
